

## **USEFUL PHRASES**

- In the photo there is/are ... who/which ...
- I think the photo was taken in ... because ...
  - At the top/bottom I can see ...
    - Next to ...
- In the foreground/background/middle of the picture I can see ...
  - What is fascinating about this photo is/are ... because ...
    - I have noticed that ...
    - If you take a closer look, you can see ...
    - The background looks interesting because ...

## LANGUAGE

- Use present progressive for actions.
- Use simple present for states (Zustände).
  - Use a lot of different adjectives.
- Say "in" the picture, not "on" the picture!

## When describing a picture, you can mention

- whom or what you can see (there is/there are, I can see, it shows...)
- the *place*
- the season
- what is happening (they are running, shopping, biking, buying things)
- the *mood* (look happy, sad, excited)
- what has just happened (they have just started doing it)
- what is going to happen next (they are going to go home)
- opinion words (I think, I guess, I believe, it seems to me that, I don't think, it must be, it could be, one possibility is that..., to my mind, as far as I am concerned, I tend to think that, my personal view is that, They seem to have a good time/ to be enjoying themselves. I'm not sure if.../I wonder what.../I suppose/Maybe...)
