

Past Perfect Tense

Die **Past Perfect Tense** verwendest du in einer Erzählung in der Past Tense für Dinge, die noch **vor der Erzählzeit** stattgefunden haben.

Bsp: **John waited for the bus home** **after he had finished work.**
 Erzählung in der Past Tense *frühere Handlung in der Past Perfect Tense*

 I went to bed before I had finished my dinner.

- g) I phoned Maria at about eight. She went out at six.
 I phoned Maria, but she had already gone out.
 After I had phoned Maria she went out.

- h) Mrs. Marple sold her car. Then she bought a new one.
 After Mrs. Marple had bought a new one she sold her car.
 After Mrs. Marple had sold her car she bought a new one.

- i) Anna started French and then she went to Paris for a year.
 When Anna went to Paris she had already started French.
 When Anna started French she had already gone to Paris.
